**GREEKTOWN CASINO-HOTEL SETTLES INHERITED VIOLATIONS**  
*Violations occurred under previous ownership and management*

**September 8, 2015 (DETROIT)** – The violations issued by the Michigan Gaming Control Board (MGCB) and acknowledged today by Greektown Casino-Hotel were all inherited as the result of the current ownership’s acquisition of the property in April 2013. All of the violations occurred under the previous ownership and management. The fine reflects an overall settlement of a number of violations that took place over several years.

“While none of the violations occurred under our ownership and management, we have taken responsibility as the casino licensee and worked with the MGCB to fully understand and resolve the inherited matters,” said Matt Cullen, CEO of Rock Gaming and Vice Chair of the Board of Greektown Casino-Hotel. “We are eager to put these matters behind us as we continue with our work to revitalize the property.”

Going forward, Greektown Casino-Hotel is committed to ensuring it institutes the best compliance practices in the industry.

Greektown Casino-Hotel is nearing completion of a very significant investment in the property, including spending \$60 million in renovations and capital improvements to enhance the casino experience for our guests. The enhancements include modernizing the casino’s interior, a new dining experience at PRISM restaurant, adding 400 new slot machines and launching a new players club program (GT Rewards), as well as installing a state-of-the-art HVAC system for improved air quality.

“These efforts are being led by our new leadership team comprised of industry experts that we have recruited from across the country. We are very excited about the future of Greektown Casino-Hotel,” said Cullen.
